Student Members

Students undertaking an accredited program of clinical psychology training are required to complete supervised placements or may undertake work approved by the Psychology Board of Australia before obtaining qualifications.

To be eligible for the ACPA/IHG insurance you must hold Student Membership of ACPA and be supervised by a clinical psychologist that holds accredited qualifications in clinical psychology. This work must be supervised, within an accredited post-graduate clinical psychology program or with approval of the Psychology Board of Australia, or within a Registrar program for full-time PhD students.

Associate Members

Clinical Psychology graduates are required to undertake a Registrar Program of supervised practice to meet the endorsement requirements of the Psychology Board of Australia in clinical psychology.

Associate Members must hold Associate Membership of ACPA and be supervised by a clinical psychologist that holds accredited qualifications in clinical psychology.

Why do I need Insurance Cover?

The above programs and duties may expose you to potential litigation from clients claiming negligence (Professional Indemnity) or personal injury (Public Liability). The insurance policy included in the ACPA membership will cover you in the chance this did occur.

ACPA Student and New Graduate Inclusive Insurance Fast Facts

- Complies with Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) requirements
- Professional Indemnity Cover
 - \$2 million for any individual claim
 - \$6 million for total claims
- Public Liability Cover
 - \$10 million in Public Liability Cover
 - \$10 million in Goods Sold and Supplied
 - \$30 million for total claims
- No excess amount applies to any claim
- Covers you Australia wide
- Cover commences from 4pm the day of application
- Once your Student/Registrar program is complete or your ACPA membership expires your insurance ceases immediately. You will then need to purchase an Insurance Policy as offered to standard members
- To Qualify for ACPA member inclusive insurance your supervisor must be a Clinical Psychologist holding an accredited Post-Graduate Degree in Clinical Psychology
